Behaviour concerns

At Gordano we have high expectations around behaviour and respect within our community. When students' behaviour does not meet the expectations of the school, we will always ensure that we act rigorously and in line with our Behaviour Policy, which can be viewed on the school website. We also recognise and are proud of the fact that the vast majority of our students at Gordano School meet our high expectations every day.

In order for us to ensure that we can support all our students effectively, can we ask you to encourage your child, if they ever have any concerns to report them to:

- a member of our staff body as soon as possible
- to speak with their tutor
- to speak to a member of the safeguarding or pastoral team
- Additionally, students can also report concerns online or remotely via our <u>Student</u> <u>Concern Log</u>

This will ensure that we can address any matters that may arise.

We have been doing a lot of work on improving behaviour both inside and outside the classroom, through:

- Focus in our Monday Broadcast messages each week
- Outside agency support e.g., the Police have delivered sessions to Year 9 on the impact of antisocial behaviour and social media
- Key area of focus for teaching and learning observations
- Review of our 'Focus' area and new staffing
- CPD (Continuing Professional Development) sessions for staff
