Required

You will need this equipment over the next 2 years and I strongly recommend you buy it...our shears are not great and it means you have your own forever.

I still use my equipment from my A'Level / Degree.

- Kit box for kit (decorated shoe box is fine)
- 1 pair fabric shears (orange handle are best but expensive so as long as they are sharp)

- 1 pack assorted machine needles
- 1 tape measure
- 2 pieces of tailors chalk

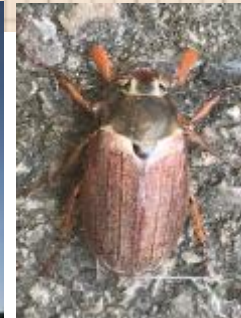
PRIMARY RESEARCH: It's vital you have primary research to help develop and inspire your work. In the holiday we would like you to:

1) Nature photography...

- Nature walk: you could go on a walk with your camera/phone and take photo's of nature around you. This may be looking at the water, rocks on the beach, colours from nature, the woods in the local area, sunsets ...
- What's around you: you may decide you want to research the human form so take images of hands, hair, eyes, etc...
- Visits: you could look at animals so pop to one of the local zoo's and photograph the animal markings, their habitat and more.
- Or choose another natural forms theme that you can take primary photo's of...the choice is yours.

2) Present your work...

- On A3 card or paper, present you images in an inspiring way to capture this initial theme.
- Consider the layout, colour, you may wish to add further texture, annotate with ideas...
