**Dear Parents and Carers** 

I hope you have had a positive week. At Gordano this week we have welcomed Challenge Partners into school for the last 3 days. Challenge Partners are a group of 6 senior leaders from other schools across the country who support us in exploring all areas of the school from curriculum, behaviour and attitudes, personal development and leadership. It has been a positive experience and I will feedback their findings once we have received their report. # Roadworks and student arrival at school

We have had a significant number of roadworks on the approaches to school from all directions recently, and some of these will continue in the coming days and weeks. Please be aware that if students are late as a result of these, they must enter school through the front gates, these are the only gates that will be open after 8.45am. If students are dropped in the coach park, off Clevedon Road, they will need to walk back down the pavement to the front gates. Due to the number of roadworks and the impact on traffic in the area, we will be delaying the implementation of our new lates system (detailed in last weeks' communication). However, we would still ask for your support in ensuring a punctual (and safe) arrival at school for students.
