Dear Parents and Carers

It has been a positive and busy week at Gordano. The senior leadership team have really enjoyed walking the school and seeing the range of learning happening across the curriculum as well as the engagement from our young people across the school; such a brilliant start to the academic year. We look forward to this continuing through the term - so far students across the school have amassed 45,000 merits since the start of the academic year!

It was good to meet with Year 12 parents at our information evening last night. I hope you found the information useful, and we will be sure to make the presentation available to all parents as soon as possible. To ensure that we can manage numbers you will be required to book a space using the links below. Whilst we will be sharing the slide deck from each evening for parents unable to attend, we do encourage you to join us if you are able. The premise of each evening is to look at the year ahead and to ensure as parents you are able to fully support your child in the next steps. If you are a parent that has children in different year groups and therefore are unable to attend each meeting - then we do suggest prioritising exam year students or your Year 7 child and then using the slide decks that we will provide for the specific year group information. Due to space limitations, we do ask that only parents come to the evening/s.

There are 2 sessions for each year, 6pm and 6.45pm with 200 seats available at each.

Parents of students in Year 13 are welcome on Thursday 19th September where we will be running one session in the main hall between 6pm and 7pm. There is no need to book.



Open Evening Arrangements

On Thursday 26th September we will be hosting our annual information evening. As in previous years, the school will close early for students on the day to enable staff to set up for the evening ahead. To ensure that students can have lunch on the school site we will have a slightly shorter Period 4 lesson, which will end at 12.35pm, then lunch. Students will be registered at 1.05pm and then will have a staggered release from school at approximately 1.10pm. This is then followed by our 3rd INSET day on Friday 27th September.

Gordano School Careers Convention: Thursday 3rd October 6-8pm

We are delighted to be hosting a wide range of employers and educational providers again at our annual Careers Convention. This event is open to all year groups **but is particularly important for students in Years 9-13** as they think about their GCSE, Post-16/18 options and work experience.

In addition to the stands in the Main Hall and Dining Hall there will be a series of talks on Apprenticeships, College and University in the Sixth Form Hall throughout the evening. We will prioritise these talks to Year 10, 11 and Sixth Form students and their families but there will be lots of information and future opportunities for students in lower years to learn about these options.

We would highly recommend travelling on foot to this event as parking is limited on site.

Year 7 Reading and Spelling assessments

From Monday 16th September, your child will be completing a reading and a spelling assessment (the NGRT and NGST respectively) within their English lesson. There is nothing your child can do to prepare for these assessments and nor do we expect them to. Start of the school day

As you are aware, at the start of this academic year we slightly changed the school day timings. As such the school day starts 5 minutes earlier than last year. Please can you ensure that your child arrives in school at 8.35am, ready for lessons/tutor time to start at 8.40. We will be starting our late detentions from the week beginning 16th September, this is for students who are late twice or more in a week. Your support in ensuring your child is in school on time would be greatly appreciated.

Jewellery and Body Piercings

The uniform and appearance of students has been pleasing so far; thank you for your support with this. However, we do need to take this opportunity to remind parents and students about our expectations around jewellery and body piercings to avoid any upset. Expensive jewellery should not be brought to school. Staff reserve the right to ask students to remove make-up/jewellery that they consider to be inappropriate for school. Students can wear 1 necklace, 1 bracelet, 1 ring on each hand, 1 watch. No other facial piercings, spacer style or spiked earrings allowed.

For Health and Safety reasons, the school does not permit body piercing apart from one pair of small (maximum of 5mm in diameter) stud or sleeper earring in the ear lobe. We reminded parents before the summer break that body piercings usually take at least 6 months to heal and recommend that students did not get any piercings over the summer that cannot comfortably and easily be removed for school come September. The expectation is that any visible body piercings will need to be removed during school hours, regardless of whether they are fully healed. Students are not permitted to wear nose studs, and this includes clear retainers.

Safeguarding

Just a reminder to parents to be aware of the law on vaping: i.e. it is illegal to sell nicotine vaping products to anyone under the age of 18 and illegal for under 18s to be using these products. Since the start of term, we have had an increase in reported concerns regarding students vaping in the Portishead community and the use of balloons. We continue to educate our young people regarding the impact of using these products. As such, if any such product is brought onto the school site this would be crossing a 'red line' which students are fully aware of. The school will significantly sanction any student breaching this school rule. We encourage you to also have these discussions at home and to contact the safeguarding or pastoral team if you have concerns about your son or daughter.

Election for Parent Governors

There are currently 2 vacancies for elected parent governors on the school's Local Governing Board (LGB), and we're inviting parents to stand for election or to nominate another parent to do so.
