# ACTIVITIES WEEK 2022 - YEAR 7

Proposed arrangements for Year 7 for Activities Week are as follows:

## Residential to Wales - 2 nights / 3 days

The vast majority of Year 7 students will be attending the residential to Wales. You have already received information about this and will be aware of the dates of your child's trip.

## Trip to Bristol Zoo

All year 7 students will be going to Bristol Zoo on the week beginning Monday 4<sup>th</sup> July as part of their Activities Week programme. This letter is to confirm the arrangements for that day.

Bristol Zoo is closing forever in September 2022 so this is one of the last opportunities to visit this iconic scientific and educational establishment. It is going to be a full day, visiting all of the areas of interest.

Students will need to be at school by 8:45am and make their way to the Science labs where they will be registered and taken down to the coaches. We will leave the zoo by 2:30pm and arrive back at Gordano around 3.15pm.

This is an educational visit and is very much part of their science lessons this year. We will talk about this trip before we go in Science lessons and afterwards in follow up lessons. There will be work to do in a special booklet, so they should bring a pen and a pencil with them. The work is marked by Science teachers and the scores are entered into the House Challenge Trophy, with the highest scores for effort and completion.

Students should bring a packed lunch. Food can be purchased at the zoo but it tends to be very expensive. It is suggested they bring a cagoule/waterproofs/sun cream due to the changeable weather and the openness of the area.
