## Positive Covid cases this week

Having had a very quiet 10 days on the Covid front for students compared with most schools, we were informed of a number of positive cases in Years 7 and 8 today. This is in line with the current pattern locally and nationally.

We have worked very hard to identify and isolate close contacts today. All parents / carers of the close contacts will receive a further email tomorrow regarding the arrangements for work for the remaining days of term and regarding the end of their isolation period. We're really sorry that the last few days of term and the first few days of the holidays have been affected for some.

Parents of those absent from school having been asked to self-isolate do <u>not</u> need to inform the attendance line each day. However, it is essential that parents of students absent for any other reason do inform the attendance line promptly in the morning. This enables us to identify any absent students who should be on site much more quickly, which is an essential part of our safeguarding duty. Many thanks for your support with this

## New household account feature for parents reporting test results

NHS Test and Trace are continuing to develop and improve the process for self-test reporting. Currently, if a parent is submitting results through their account on behalf of a child, they have to enter the child's details every time they report a result.

As a result of feedback from parents, NHS Test and Trace have introduced household accounts. This allows parents to save their children's details to their own user accounts so parents can report results for multiple members in the household more quickly and easily.

When reporting self-test results parents will now be offered the opportunity to create a household account, which should take no more than 2 minutes. Parents can
