Dear Parents and Carers

Thank you for all your support in ensuring that the roads around the school remain safe for all in our community at those busy times. Please bear in mind the following:

• The coach park off Clevedon Road is a good place to drop off safely off-road but is also used as parking for school staff so can be particularly busy in the morning. Please only drop and go in this area. The access onto the road can be difficult and needs particular care. The gates from the coach park are locked at 8.40am so after this time students will need to walk back to the main gate.
