The curtain raiser was the ever-popular staff relay which was won by Portland House who obviously inspired the Portland students to continue their winning ways.

Two school records were broken. Martha H added the Year 8 girls 200m record to the Year 7 100m record she broke last year, with a time of 27.47 secs. The Year 10 Portland girls smashed the 4x100m relay record which had stood for 22 years, with a time of 55.08 secs, knocking over 3 seconds off the previous record. ## Reintroduction of biometric payments for school meals

The school will be reinstating the biometric payment system from the start of the new school year in September. In preparation for this we will be arranging fingerprint scanning for all students whose parents/carers have consented. If you have previously consented to your child's fingerprint being scanned, your child will be asked to attend the scanning sessions. If you have previously refused consent your child will not have their finger scanned. If you would like to change your previous decision around consent, please email our <a href="Data Team">Data Team</a> to amend your child's record.

Scanning for Years 7 to 10 will take place during the week commencing 10th July. Year 11 students who are attending Bridging Week prior to starting Sixth Form and also Year 12 will be scanned during the week commencing 26th June. ## Drop off and pick up

We need to remind parents that they must not come onto the school site to drop off students in the morning or pick them up at the end of the day. This is presenting some concerns about safety currently. We appreciate that parking around the school can be difficult and would encourage all students that can to walk or cycle to and from school.

From Monday 26<sup>th</sup> June we will be changing the arrangements for opening gates at the end of the school day. The main gates will remain open, as will the gates to St Mary's Road and Greenfield Park. The pedestrian gate onto Clevedon Road next to the coach park, and the pedestrian gate into the coach park from the field will remain locked. Students will need to access the coach park from the front car park next to the English block. Any students that would normally have left via the pedestrian gate on to Clevedon Road must now leave via the Greenfield Park gate please. We will be making students aware of this on Monday morning in their weekly briefing.

Our thanks for your cooperation with this, and for refraining from parking in the bus stop next to the St Mary's Road gate which, the Neighbourhood Police Team remind us all, is an offence.
