Student safety

We have been made aware of the concern below regarding stick and poke tattoo's and felt it was important to share this information with you as parents so that you can be vigilant.

Can you do a stick and poke tattoo at home?

If you can't afford a professional tattoo or you don't have access to a tattoo parlor, **you can give yourself** a tattoo at home without a tattoo gun, using what is sometimes called the "stick-and-poke" method. This process can be dangerous, however, and if it turns out badly, you're left with a permanent reminder.



Uniform correction process

Can we thank parents for supporting your child to be in the correct school uniform since the start of term. Generally, standards of uniform have been extremely high, and we are very keen for this to continue throughout the year. Please be aware that over the course of the first two weeks we will continue to work with you to ensure all unform is correct in preparation for the week beginning 19th September. After this point any student wearing the incorrect uniform or missing a uniform item will be given two options:

- 1. Offered spare uniform to put on for that day
- 2. Parents/Carers will be contacted to either bring in the correct uniform/give permission for the student to go home and put on the correct uniform

If a student doesn't take one of the above options, they will be placed in the focus room for a full day and will be expected to complete a 20 minute after school detention on the same day. Please do get in touch with your child's pastoral team if you need any assistance in ensuring that your child is in the correct uniform. Please refer to the <u>letter</u> sent out prior to the summer holidays which will provide clarity on our expectations around uniform and appearance. We'd like to thank you in advance for your co-operation and support.
