



Dear Parent/ Guardian,

We want our students to make informed choices about their future careers. The annual Careers Convention is one of our keystone careers events but for obvious reasons is not tenable this year.

We are happy to announce that in place of our Careers Convention, we invite parents and students to attend a **virtual event on the 25th of November** organised by Like to Be. The event is comprised of live workshops and recorded content. The event lasts until 6 pm so students will be able to engage in live content after school as well as watch recorded content. Moreover, we encourage students (and/or parents) to submit questions to speakers beforehand.

Students must set up a Like to Be account and register for the event to access the content before the event starts. Registration also allows students to use other functions available on the Like to Be website, the primary goal of which is to enable a safe online space for students to meet, question and network with people from a variety of career sectors. As this event is organised by a third party that requires the submission of some personal data (name, e-mail, gender and location), **registration should only be completed with parental/guardian consent**. We advise that students use their school e-mail addresses and limit the amount of personal data shared.

To participate in the Virtual Careers Convention we ask that:

- Students register for a Like to Be account at www.liketobe.org by the 24th of November (instructions [here](#))
- Once logged in, students register for the **West of England Careers Inspiration Show** [here](#)
- Students submit questions for speakers on the forum page of the event by the 20th of November (instructions [here](#))
- Students engage with both the live and recorded content at home on the 25th of November (and following days if necessary). A provisional schedule is [here](#) but we advise that you check the Like to Be website for the most recent information.
