Punctuality

Last week students were given clear expectations around punctuality. It is vital that students arrive to school on time and at the latest time of 8.40am, ready to be in tutor time at 8.45am. This is so important in terms of ensuring that students do not miss tutor time and assemblies as this is a key part of starting the school day positively and to ensure that students have all the relevant and key information for the day and week ahead. This week we have seen several students not making it to school on time and we want to ensure that arriving on time is a habit that students get into very early in the year. We very much appreciate the support of parents with this. The lates sanctions have now started, and any student who is late to school twice or more in one week will receive an after-school detention the following Monday.

Nasal Flu Immunisations – 28th & 29th November

Students in Years 7 – 11 are being offered flu vaccinations this winter to help protect them from flu and serious complications such as bronchitis and pneumonia. Vaccinating your child will also help protect you, your family and friends. The flu vaccine is administered using a nasal spray, this vaccine is free and painless. As you are aware, we have established there are two small areas of RAAC in the Gordano school buildings. We are working with the DfE to implement our plan of action to deal with this and get to a position where we can reopen the corridor we have closed off as part of our safety mitigations.

We have also had the DfE appointed surveyor in school this week, and we are happy to report that they have concluded that these are the only areas of RAAC usage throughout the Gordano School estate.
