Careers: Teatime Networking

We had a very successful Teatime Networking session focussing on the Finance Industry on Wednesday evening after school. Representatives from Mercer Marsh Benefits, Deloitte, RSM Finance, Evelyn and Partners, Exeter University and our own Natalie Fear talked to students from Year 9 to 13 about their what it is like to work in that sector and in their relative companies covering topics such as how the business works, different routes into the profession, apprenticeships, Degree level routes and work experience. It was a great evening and students found it really helpful.

RAG funds

Thank you for supporting Sixth Form's RAG Week before half term; our students' efforts have raised over £3,000 for our twinned schools in Kenya (Mend the Gap) and Cancer Research.

Sexual Health Project

The School Nursing Service is currently undertaking a sexual health project in collaboration with Barnardo's with a goal of improving outcomes for our young people across Bristol, North Somerset and South Gloucestershire. The initial stage of the project involves distributing a survey to young people in secondary school who are currently in year 9 or above. The survey is totally voluntary – and students are not required to complete it. The survey is particularly interested in students' knowledge of the C Card Scheme.

We will share the survey with students at the end of the month, and Barnardo's are then looking for Year 12 student volunteers to form a student voice focus group; we will be asking for volunteers.
