I have worked in various special educational schools for nearly 19 years as a SENDCo and Assistant Head teacher and prior to that, as a teacher of art. Throughout my experience I have developed a sound knowledge of SEND with a specialism in social, emotional and mental health needs and the behaviours that are often displayed as a form of communication. I am passionate about nurturing and supporting each individual child to achieve their full potential during their time at Gordano school through identifying barriers and implementing the appropriate support.

I am looking forward to building upon the strong foundations already in place for the SEND department built by the dedication of the SEND team and my predecessor over the years. I will be concentrating on familiarising myself with the pupils and their pupil passports, plans and EHCPs during term 3.
