Late to School – New Procedures

From Monday 21st November we will be changing our procedures for students who are late to school. The St Mary's Road gate will continue to be closed at 8.40am, and any student arriving at the Clevedon Road gate after 8.45am will be noted as late by the member of staff on duty. Parents / carers will then receive a text to alert them to the fact their child has been late to school. Any child who is late to school twice in one week without a valid reason will receive a half hour after school detention on the following Monday. Parents / carers of a student who has three or more lates detentions in one term will be invited into school to meet with a member of the senior leadership team.
