Dear Parents and Carers

Sixth Form Open Evening

However, we encourage students to join us on this evening and to be curious about the many ways they can study and build their career pathways if they stay with us. Students rarely get the opportunity to see Sixth Form from the 'inside' before Year 12; we encourage all students to come and visit the full range of subject stands, book into post 16 talks, hear about the extra-curricular, employability and leadership opportunities on offer and experience the 'more independent' way they can continue to study at Gordano after Year 11.

Our Open Evening is the formal launch of the Sixth Form application process.

Police

We continue to work closely with our local police, and they have asked us to remind parents to speak to students about fireworks in the lead up to Bonfire Night (it is illegal to set off fireworks in public places and police continue to have concerns about firework safety).

E-Scooters

We have shared information about E-Scooters on behalf of the police previously (see below), but they have asked us to issue a reminder to students and parents that it is illegal to ride a private scooter in public spaces or on public roads.
