LEARNING OVERVIEW

I have the privilege to frequently and continually spend time in lessons around the school. This term, departments have been focusing on building on prior learning and ensuring that students are confident about their knowledge and understanding about the subject. It is a term full of learning and it was described to students as the last bend of an athletics race. It is a time when you can see the finish line, but do not want to go too soon and start cramming and worrying about the end. Students should pace themselves with frequent, planned revision activities and demonstrate their knowledge by completing past paper questions – then marking them and reflecting on their progress.

Year 11 lessons have been full of learning, revision and feedback to help students feel confident and be able to demonstrate their understanding in longer assessments.

It is always a real pleasure to spend time in lessons, to look at books and discuss with students – how they feel about their subjects and preparation.


