St Mary's Road Gate

Thank you to parents who raised their concerns regarding the St Mary's Road Gate being locked at 8.40am yesterday when the weather meant it was challenging to get to the front gate due to the flooding on the road and footpath. We apologise for the inconvenience this caused. The St Mary's Gate will continue to be locked at 8.40am each morning to ensure that we can adequately register late arrivals from 8.40am on the main gates. However, we will ensure that we check that the path outside the main gate is passable and if it is not, we will keep St Mary's Road gate open only on very wet days. As a school, we have reported the issues caused by the flooding of Lipgate Place during heavy rainfall to North Somerset Council who are responsible for the maintenance of the drains, but parents can also report their concerns directly to North Somerset Council.
