Year 11

We are beginning to plan for an appropriate time for some Year 11 students to be offered optional study leave. This is likely to be offered after Celebration Day (2nd May). This day falls earlier than in previous years, because exams start in earnest the following week. This optional study leave will be offered to students who are on track to achieve their target grades and have demonstrated that they can study/revise independently. These students remain welcome to attend any revision lessons; there will also be a supervised study space on site. For students we ask to stay in school rather than going on study leave, the aim is to provide structured support and guidance; we will also be planning well-being and reward opportunities as part of this provision.

This is not a punishment in any way; we just know that some students will still need and indeed want our guidance, and we don't want to remove this structure and support too early.

After May half term, study leave will be offered to everyone, but revision lessons and bespoke support as appropriate will still run during the school day. We aim to inform students and parents of the plan for each individual student towards the end of the week beginning 22nd April.
