**Olusoga, Beard and Jarman** all used skeletons to help them discover the past. As Archaeologists they can analyse the Carbon Isotopes in bones to determine the place of death, the person's diet and even the geography of their upbringing..

Archaeology: The study of human history through the excavation of sites and study of physical remains

**Excavation:** digging on a historic site to uncover information about the past

Adams used textiles to uncover stories of women in the Dark Ages. The Dark Ages are challenging to research due to the lack of source material that survives. For example, textiles easily decay.

**BC**: Before Christ **AD**: Anno Domini

Decade: 10 years Century: 100 years Millenium: 1000 years


BC <u>always</u> comes before AD In BC, bigger numbers happened earlier. In AD, smaller numbers happened earlier.


