RAG week 2024: Raising and Giving Money to Caring in Bristol and Cancer Research

This year the Sixth Form RAG week promises to be even bigger than previous years! Running from Monday 16th December to Friday 20th December, the Sixth Form will be hosting a number of events and dress-up themes throughout this final week of term.

Lower school students can get involved by supporting our main fundraising event on Wednesday 18th December, the Christmas RAG Fayre. The fayre offers a range of things to do and buy including games, challenges, cake stalls, hot dogs and face-painting to name a few. Students who are having Christmas lunch in the dining hall can come across after their festive fare and join in the fun. To help support the event, students will need to bring in cash on the day or purchase tokens in advance via ParentPay. Each token is worth 25p, and they will be given to students a few days before the event to use as currency.

Students can also come along at lunchtime on Monday 16th December and watch the highly contested Sixth Form Students v Staff Dodgeball match in the old Sports Hall. Entrance fee of 50p with cash donations on the door.

Finally, any student in year 10 and above can buy a ticket via ParentPay for our RAG Fest on Thursday 19th December 7 – 9.30 p.m. in the Main Hall to hear a range of students performing in a combination of solo acoustic sets to larger bands. There is even an opportunity to take part in some karaoke.

The two charities to whom we will be donating all the proceeds are Caring in Bristol and Cancer Research. Caring in Bristol runs the specific Caring at Christmas programme which is the South-West's biggest Christmas homeless project, supporting people experiencing homelessness in Bristol throughout Christmas.

To further support this cause, we are collecting donations that will be delivered to the centre on Thursday 19th December. A list of items required are attached. There are donation boxes for goods in each house area, the Sixth Form office and main reception.
